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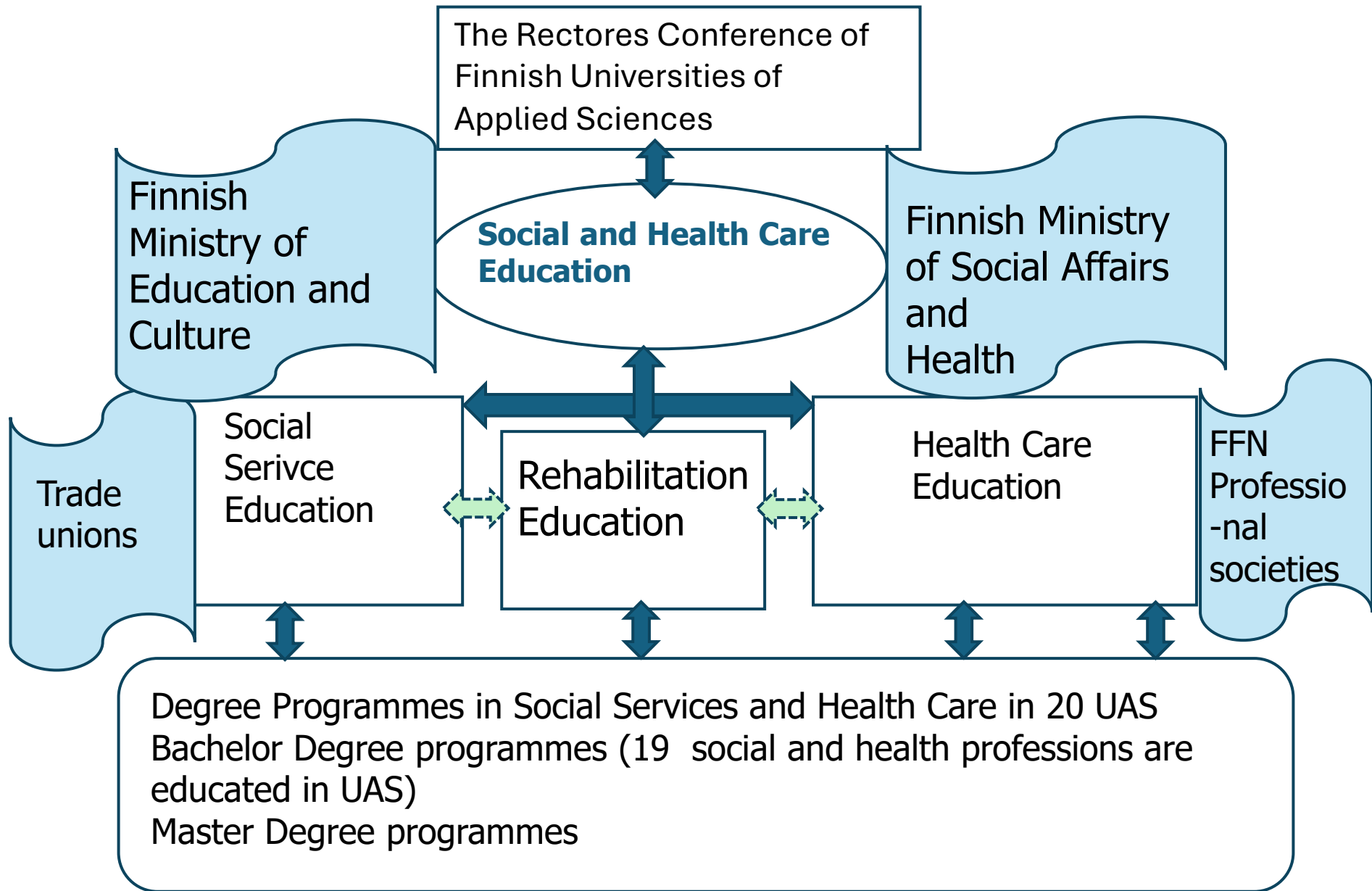

Patient and client safety competence, learning aims and some examples of content:

- 1) Demonstrates knowledge of key factors regarding patient and client safety: *Patient safety legislation • Fields of patient safety: equipment safety, nursing care safety, safety of interventions, drug safety and medication safety • Patient safety culture • Radiation safety*
- 2) Promotes patient safety and prevents patient safety incidents in every phase of the nursing process of the patient: *• Efficient team work to ensure patient safety • Prevention of patient safety incidents in nursing • Human factors as risk to patient safety • Stress management skills • Learning from mistakes to prevent harm*
- 3) Communicates clearly to ensure patient safety: *Methodical tool for structured reporting (ISBAR)*
- 4) Takes immediate situation specific action in a hazardous situations: *Situation specific action in hazardous situation • Intervention in threatening situations involving risk to patient safety*
- 5) Recognizes potential patient safety incidents and reports them: *Obligation to report patient safety incidents • Recognition of patient safety incidents*
- 6) Understands how a report on patient safety incident is handled: *Handling process of the report of patient safety incident*
